

Catalina 27 Leaving the Boat Checklist

- **Did anything break?** Take Pictures and measurements. Email details to RSC Maintenance Officer, President and other Catalina 27 Skippers and write it up in the dock box logbook. Project manage the repair. Get spending approval and purchase supplies. Get help and involve experts when necessary.
- **Head:**
 - Pump out tank or empty porta-potty. Add Kills Odors to holding tanks.
 - Fill water tank on porta-potty
 - Clean toilet and head compartment
 - Through-hull closed!
 - Does head need more supplies? Toilet Paper, Kills Odors, small plastic bags, garbage bags... go replenish
- **Galley:**
 - Clean Galley
 - Release pressure in Stove
 - Close Sink Through-Hull!
 - Empty Trash
 - Fill water tank
 - Empty water in Dry-z-air (Don't pour it in the lake or down the sink!) refill crystals
 - Does galley need any supplies? Dry-z-air, paper towels, garbage bags, stove fuel... go replenish
- **Cabin:**
 - Clean and stow everything. Take all personal items with you.
 - Shake out carpet as needed
 - Forward Hatch shut and locked
 - Check bilge. Pump if necessary
- **Electrical**
 - VHF off
 - Chartplotter off, covered, stowed
 - Inverter off
 - All 12 volt panel switches off
 - Main battery switch off
 - In a marina? Connect 30 amp power cord.
- **Engine:**
 - Fuel: if tank less than ½ full, fill with 87+ octane non-ethanol gasoline
 - Close fuel vent
 - Deadman key in galley sink
- **Cockpit/Rigging**
 - Stow winch handle in stb. Locker
 - Coil and stow all lines
 - Stow fenders and extra lines in port cockpit locker
 - Clean deck and cockpit with freshwater, scrub brush and elbow grease. Clean debris from cockpit scupper strainer.
 - Attach Backstay pendent
 - Flake and tie main, ease lazyjacks, and cover main.
 - Coil mainsheet and hang on stern rail with cow hitch
 - Furl jib tightly with Sunbrella facing out, Cleat hitch inhaul/outhaul line, and trim jib sheets
 - Cover rudder and lash to center.
 - Cover Winches and Compass
 - Ease lifelines
 - Companionway shut and locked canvas cover snapped
- **Mooring**
 - Bridle and bowline connected to mooring buoy
 - Fenders stowed
 - Stern mooring line coiled with cow hitch to stern rail
 - Lifelines down so birds don't roost on them
- **Sign boat back into logbook**
