Q&A

Q. What kind of boats does RSC have available?

A. RSC maintains a fleet of 15-foot RS Visions, 14-foot Catalina Capris, and a variety of larger boats ranging from 17 to 27 feet in length.

Q. Does RSC rent out boats?

A. RSC does not rent out boats. Members and class participants may use the boats.

Q. Do I have to be a member to take a class?

A. Anyone age 12+ is welcome to participate in small boat classes (16+ for keelboat).

Q. What does membership cost?

A. Membership costs \$250 per year for the use of smaller boats. If you wish to use the larger boats, there is an additional \$155 annual maintenance fee. These costs cover an individual or family.
