Rescue Boat Checklist

Start Up

General Checklist

- 1. check fuel in tank
- 2. refill when necessary with a fuel/oil mixture of 40:1
- 3. unlock padlock and unwrap chain from motor shaft

Engine

- 1. lower engine by raising, then releasing lock on front of transom
- 2. attach fuel line
- 3. loosen cap on fuel tank
- 4. pump fuel
- 5. shift to neutral
- 6. pull out choke
- 7. pull rope to start engine
- 8. restore choke as needed
- 9. allow engine to warm up until the idle is stable at a SHIFT rpm

Finish

Engine

- 1. unplug fuel line
- 2. run the engine until it stops
- 3. tighten cap on fuel tank
- 4. raise the engine and allow it to latch in the storage position

General Checklist

- 1. pull the boat onto the dock
- 2. wrap the chain around the motor shaft and attach the padlock
- 3. check the quantity in the fuel tank and note if a refill is necessary
- 4. return the fuel tank to the lock box
