<p>1. Attach Jib Halyard to Bow Pulpit</p>		<p>6. Trim and Cleat Main and Jib Halyards. Finish with cow hitches on hand rail</p>	
<p>2. Flake and bag Jib. 3. Stow jibs in ledge above V-Birth with Jibs to port and Spinnakers to starboard. Spare Main and Storm Jib Forward. Labels facing out.</p>		<p>7. Trim Traveler to Port or Starboard of the Companionway. 8. Trim Main Sheet</p>	
<p>4. Attach Backstay Pendant and Main Halyard to boom End</p>		<p>9. Cow Hitch Main Sheet on Boom</p>	
<p>5. Flake, Tie and Cover Main</p>		<p>10. Cover Winches 11. Coil tail of traveler around winch</p>

<p>12. Cover Compass</p>		<p>18. Hang ignition kill lanyard from chart plotter mounting arm</p>	
<p>13. Attach to Mooring with cleat hitch. Check mooring line for chaffe.</p>		<p>19. Coil Jib Sheets stow on salon table with winch handle</p>	
<p>14. Close Fuel Vent</p>		<p>20. Clean up any bird droppings and footprints with freshwater, a scrub brush and elbow grease.</p>	
<p>15. Check Fuel level. Refill with non-ethanol gasoline if less than 1/2 full.</p>		<p>21. Clean Solar Pannels</p>	
<p>16. Cover Tiller</p> <p>17. Lash tiller to center. Bowline to port and then trim rolling hitch to starboard</p>		<p>22. Empty Trash</p>	

# Un-rigging the Ranger 24

<p>23. Empty Clean and refill toilet</p>	
<p>24. Empty and Refill Dry-Z-Air in sink and bucket to starboard of galley.</p>	
<p>25. Latch foredeck hatch</p>	
<p>26. Turn off all Electrical switches</p>	
<p>27. Battery disconnect switch to Off</p>	

<p>28. Check Battery Voltage and Level. Note any low levels.</p>	
<p>29. Check, pump and clean bilge. Note excess water.</p>	
<p>30. Clean Cabin Sole, galley countertop and any other messes</p>
